Tanis, Incorporated (Tanis) certifies our products are following in compliance with Directive 2011/EU of the European Parliament and the Council of June8, 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (also so kwon as "RoHS Recast"). Tanis declares that none of these metals and or substances are found in our products and if they are, they do not exceed the maximum concentration of 0.1% by weight in homogeneous materials for lead, hexavalent chromium, mercury, polybrominated biphenyl (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) and 0.01% for cadmium, Bis(2 -ethyhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)(0.1%), Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)(0.1%), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)(0.1%), Diisobutyl Phthalate (DIBP)(0.1%), N-(hydroxymethyl) acrylamide.

Tanis also declares that none of the substances of very high concern, as listed by REACH, are in our products or that they do not exceed the maximum threshold of 0.1% based on weight.

Furthermore, Tanis declares that our products do not use the 3TG conflict minerals (tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold).
